Zechariah 3:1-9

1. Go To _____. (Verse 1)

All the leaders of the priests and the people became more and more unfaithful. They followed the pagan practices of the surrounding nations, desecrating the Temple of the Lord in Jerusalem. The Lord, the God of their ancestors, repeatedly sent his prophets to warn them, for he had compassion on his people and his Temple. But the people mocked these messengers of God and despised their words.

2. Remember God's _____. (Verse 2)

For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn, among many brothers and sisters.
