1. Choose someone who has nothing to lose by telling you the truth.
2. Choose someone who is where you eventually want to be in life.
3. If possible, ask more than one person.
4. When you ask for counsel, go into it expecting that God will speak to you.

Questions To Use When Asking

- 1) Are any of the options I'm considering outside the bounds of scripture?
- 2) What do you think the wise thing is for me to do?
- 3) What would you do if you were me?

Reasons You'll Be Tempted Not To Ask

- 1) **"I don't know anybody wise to ask."**
- 2) **"I don't need anybody to tell me what to do." (Pride)**
