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
You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight.

James 4:2

The key to understanding conflict: "I'm not getting what I want."

Question to ask: What part of the problem is mine?

(i.e. What slice of the pie?)



• If you own a slice you have to be nice."

You do not have, because you do not ask God.

James 4:3

- Have you taken this to God?
- Have you spent any time getting to the root of what it <u>really</u> is that <u>you</u> want?

When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

James 4:3

- It may be God's will to <u>not</u> give us something that will lead us down a harmful path.
- We need to learn to take no for an answer.

Application Question:

Who in your family is suffering because you're not getting your way?

What could you do today, to take the pressure off?
