Review

- What I want immediately is often in conflict with what I want ultimately.
- To get what I really want, I have to discover what I value.
- A better question: What does God want for me?
 - Answer: *The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.* Gal 5:22-23 TNIV
- What you really want, and what God wants for you, are not as far apart as you may have thought.
- The kingdom of this world cannot give you what you really want.
 - The kingdom of this world is designed to distract you from what really matters.
 - The kingdom of this world is all about upgrades and experiences.
 - If you go after that kingdom, you will never get what you really want.

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
