4 PHASES GOD USES TO CHANGE ME

1. A CRISIS: I Struggle _____

So Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him till daybreak. When the man saw that he could not overpower him, he touched the socket of Jacob's hip so that his hip was wrenched as he wrestled with the man.

Genesis 32:24-26

Even in the womb, Jacob struggled with his brother; when he became a man, he even fought with God. Yes, he wrestled with the angel and won. He wept and pleaded for a blessing from him. There at Bethel he met God face to face, and God spoke to him.

2. A COMMITMENT: I Make _____

"Then the man said, 'Let me go, for it is daybreak.' But Jacob replied, 'I will not let you go unless you bless me!'"

3. A CONFESSION: I Am _____

"The man asked him, 'What is your name?' Jacob' he answered."
Genesis 32:27

Jacob = "deceiver (manipulator)"

4. A CONVERSION: I'm Given A _____

"Then the man said, 'Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel... Then he blessed him there. So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, 'It is because I saw God face to face...'"

Genesis 32:28

Israel = "Prince with God"

"The sun rose above Jacob as he passed Peniel, and he was limping because of his hip."

Genesis 32:31
