The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm." (vs. 13- 14) Lesson: God often waits until the last second to answer. 3. in faith. Then the Lord said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground. (vs. 15-16) God usually takes you through your problems, Lesson: not around them. Then Moses raised his hand over the sea, and the Lord opened up a path through the water with a strong east wind. The wind blew all that night, turning the seabed into dry land. So the people of Israel walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground, with walls of water on each side! (vs. 21, 22) When I am afraid, I will put my confidence in God.
