o An Impossible
"It was by faith that Noah built an ark to save his family from the flood He obeyed God, who warned him about things that had never happened before." Heb. 11:7 (NLT)
1. FAITH IS BELIEVING WHEN I DON'T IT.
"Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do no see." Heb. 11:1 (TNIV)
(ABRAHAM) GOD MAY TEST YOUR FAITH WITH
o A Major
"It was by faith that Abraham obeyed when God called him to leave home and go to another land that God would give him as his inheritance He went without knowing where he was going." Heb. 11:8 (NLT)
o A Delayed

"And even when he reached the land God promised him, he lived there by faith—for he was like a foreigner, living in tents. And so did Isaac and Jacob, who inherited the same promise. Abraham was confidently looking forward to a city with eternal foundations, a city designed and built by God." Heb. 11:9-10 (NLT)

#### o An Unsolvable

By faith Abraham, even though he was past age — and Sarah herself was barren — was enabled to become a father because he considered him faithful who had made the promise. And so from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore. Heb. 11:11-12 (NIV)

# o A Senseless \_\_\_\_\_

"It was by faith that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when <u>God was</u> testing him. Abraham, who had received God's promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, even though God had promised him, 'Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted.'" Heb.11:17-18 (NLT)

# o Prolonged \_\_\_\_\_

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward. Heb. 11:24-26

### 3. FAITH IS PERSISTING WHEN I DON'T \_\_\_\_\_ IT.
